
Commodity instruments sub-fund



The investment objective of the sub-fund is a long-term increase in the value of assets as a result of investment value growth. Generali Złota is the sub-fund with exposure to gold. The sub-fund invests mainly in instruments with direct and indirect exposure to gold. The results of the sub-fund depend on the price of gold or other financial instruments issued by entities whose objects include gold exploration, mining, processing or trading. The sub-fund's portfolio mainly consists of such instruments as: gold exchange-traded commodities (ETC) classified as corporate debt instruments and exchange-traded funds (ETF), denominated in foreign currencies. In addition, the sub-fund may invest in stocks and other equity instruments. Some of its assets may be in the form of other categories of investments enumerated in the by-laws, in particular in the form of debt securities and money market instruments. The exchange rate risk is being hedged by transactions in foreign currency derivatives.

On January 11, 2020, the investment policy and the name of the fund changed. Old name of the fund - Generali Akcje Daleki Wschód.







Standard deviation – this ratio shows how risky the given fund is. The higher the ratio, the more volatile the price of a fund unit. This ratio is used to compare the risk of funds with a similar profile (e.g. equity funds).
